Section 1

12.5-hour Certification is specifically designed for those who want to be a Certified Ageless Grace Educator and be able to focus on older adults. This certification goes into depth regarding the primary and secondary benefits of each practice set. This entails how each set is practiced, creation of music playlists, safety and precautions, PR and marketing skills, basic anatomy, how to organize a class format, and a wide-variety of ideas on how to instruct these spontaneous tools that are sparked by imagination and creativity, memory and recall, kinesthetic learning, analytical thinking and strategic planning.

Educational Objectives:

At the completion of this training, participants will have an understanding of the strategies utilized to teach the 21 Simple Tools for Lifelong Comfort and Ease for older adults. The objectives include:

- ❖ Concept of neuroplasticity
- ❖ Introduction of the 21 program sets (tools)
- ❖ Three R's of Ageless Grace

- ❖ Ageless Grace workshop formats
- ❖ Understanding why the program is practiced in a chair rather than standing
- ❖ Safety guidelines and precautions of the program
- ❖ Emphasis on stimulating five functions of the brain
